^{*} In 2020, there were \$46,000 mm of U.S. exports listed as 'unknown' in origin. Primarily, these are commodities that are produced evenly enough across a number of states so that no one state can be listed as the state of origin. In 2020 this category was the fifth largest 'state' in terms of export value, slightly larger than Florida.

In 2020, \$674 mm of these exports went to GCC member countries, making the GCC the 8^{th} largest export market for this category.

On average, states send 66% of their exports to their top 10 markets and 75% to their top 15 markets.
